**Conveyor Safety Tips**

<p>Do Not Climb, Sit, Stand, Walk, Ride, or Touch the Conveyor at Any Time</p>	<p>Do Not Perform Maintenance on Conveyor Until Electrical, Air, Hydraulic and Gravity Energy Sources Have Been Locked Out and Blocked</p>	<p>Operate Equipment Only With All Approved Controls and Guards in Place</p>
<p>Do Not Load a Stopped Conveyor or Overload a Running Conveyor</p>	<p>Ensure That All Personnel Are Clear of Equipment Before Starting</p>	<p>Allow Only Authorized Personnel To Operate or Maintain Material Handling Equipment</p>
<p>Do Not Muddy or Misuse Conveyor Controls</p>	<p>Keep Clothing, Body Parts and Feet Away from Conveyors</p>	<p>Remove Trash, Paperwork and Other Debris Only When Power is Locked Out</p>
<p>Ensure That All Controls and Pull Cords are Visible and Accessible</p>	<p>Know the Location and Function of All Stop and Start Controls</p>	<p>Report All Unsafe Conditions</p>
