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## ROAD RAGE - HOW TO AVOID AGGRESSIVE DRIVING

Aggressive driving is a major concern of the American public and a real threat to the safety of everyone on the road.

How can you avoid being the victim of an aggressive driver?

Here are three guiding principles:

### #1 DON'T OFFEND

When surveys ask drivers what angers them most, the results are remarkably consistent. A few specific behaviors seem unusually likely to enrage other drivers.

*Examples:*

- Making gestures
- Driving slowly in the left lane
- Tailgating
- Cutting off



### #2 DON'T ENGAGE

One angry driver can't start a fight unless another driver is willing to join in.

You can protect yourself against aggressive drivers by refusing to become angry at them.

*Examples:*

- Steer clear
- Avoid eye contact
- Get help
