Downtown Calgary hotel evacuated due to fire

One autumn evening, a small fire, sparked by a malfunctioning appliance in one of the rooms, quickly turned into an inferno. Guests, awakened by the smell of smoke, found themselves in a nightmarish scenario as they discovered that several emergency exits were either inaccessible or inadequately marked.
