

Exit or No Exit – Picture This – Spanish



¡Decídase! Apparently, this door NO is an exit. But the confusion of the moment and the doubt that these mixed messages could result in a fire.

La moraleja: According to OSHA, doors or passages along an exit route that can be confused with an exit must be marked "Not an exit" or a similar designation, or identified by a sign indicating its actual use, for example, a storage room (Maintenance, Safeguards and operational characteristics for exit routes, Sec. 1910.137(b)(5)).

But if well the placement of signs of "this is not an exit" on a door with the indication "EXIT" technically would not be a violation of OSHA, the elimination of the sign of "EXIT" would be a much safer solution.
