Fireproof Door Manufacturer Faces \$382,500 in Proposed Fines For 76 Alleged Health and Safety Violations

Allegations include 14 instances of failing to correct hazards cited in previous OSHA inspections. Employees were allegedly being exposed to potential injury or death from fire, explosion, amputation, electrocution, laceration, chemical burn, noise and crushing hazards.
