GARAGE DOOR FAQs

My garage door is out of balance. What should I do?

The best measures to take towards proper security should cover absolutely all. As your door is the heaviest moving mechanism around your home, balancing it requires a professional. Re-balancing the door involves adjusting the tension level in the springs, and as the springs carry so much tension, they are extremely dangerous to handle by an untrained person. Stay safe and call a professional service.



Why my garage door does not close?

If the garage door opener is running, first check if the door is not disengaged by checking that the red emergency release cord was not pulled. If it was, the carriage has to be re-engaged following the instructions in the opener's manual since the procedure would vary depending on the model. Another reason could be a problem with the springs, but for that it is highly recommended to call a professional.



How often should a garage door and opener be serviced?

As your garage door is the largest moving mechanism in your home, you need to have it serviced professionally at least once a year to make sure everything is in place. One of the most important things to check is the safety measures, including the reverse mechanisms and safety sensors. You might also want to take a look at the spring's condition, as well as the cables and tracks.
