Fatal Misstep: Ladder Safety Negligence in Hotel Maintenance

A devastating accident occurred at a well-known hotel chain, resulting in the death of a maintenance worker due to a fall from a ladder.

The worker, tasked with repairing a light fixture in a high-ceilinged lobby, used an unstable ladder that was not suited for the task's height or complexity.
