PROPERTY PREVENTION: TRICKS TO STOP TICKS

Ticks are most likely to be in woods, where woods meet lawns, where lawn meets trees, tall brush, grass, under leaves, under ground cover. Tick habitats are partially, near some walls or wood piles, brush piles, around bird feeders, outside pet areas. Know the methods to prevent them.
