RECALLS

Since the establishment of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration:

- 390 Million cars, trucks, SUVs, minivans, and motor vehicles have been recalled for safety reasons.
- 46 Million cars
- 46 MILLION cases of motor vehicle equipment
- 42 Million used cars from past recalls removed.

AIR BAGS

Facts:
Air bags have been required in all passenger vehicles since 1994. In 1999, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) issued a recall of 100 million vehicles at a cost of \$200 million.

Defects Relate to a Defective Sensor Inside the Bag
The Bag Detaches at Low-Speed Impact

SEAT BELTS

Facts:
Seat belts save 50,000 lives each year.
Seat belts can reduce the risk of death in a front-end collision by 50%.

Seat Belts can Cause Serious Injuries:
Injuries can happen in a collision, especially when they fail to perform their function. Seat belt failure can cause fractures or a fatal injury in a high-speed collision.

CAR ROOF

Facts:
Using car roofs can be dangerous and life threatening.
Injuries from car roofs can range from minor to fatal.
Car roofs can be crushed during a violent accident causing serious injuries.
