THE DANGERS OF DEFECTIVE CAR PARTS

RECALLS
Since the establishment of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration

- 390 Million cars, trucks, motorcycles, and mopeds have been recalled for safety reasons.
- 46 Million cars
- 66 Million pieces of motor vehicle equipment
- 42 Million child seats have since been recalled.

AIR BAGS

Facts:
Air bags have been required in all passenger vehicles since 1985. Air bags can reduce the risk of death in a front-end collision by 29%. Air bags can reduce the risk of injury by 45%.

Common Air Bag Defects:
Fault is inherent in a serious accident, usually too late.
Tear bag.
Relative to Low-Speed Collisions.

SEAT BELTS

Facts:
Seat belts save 1,000 lives each year.
Seat belts can reduce the risk of death in a front-end collision by 50%.
Seat Belts can Cause serious injuries. The shoulder, neck, and chest. Severe neck injury or paralysis when they fail to perform their function. Seat belt failure can occur because of a faulty design or improper installation.

CAR ROOF

Facts:
Strong car roofs are an important safety feature.
Unfortunately, roofs, seats, and windows are not built to withstand a rollover accident.
Car roofs can be crushed during a rollover accident, causing serious injuries.
