Operators of MEWPs must always wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including a full-body harness attached to a designated anchor point. They should also ensure the platform is stable, inspected, and used only on firm ground. This image underscores the importance of fall protection and pre-operation safety checks to prevent potentially fatal accidents.
