**4** types of employers:



- CREATING**  
The employer that creates a hazardous condition
- EXPOSING**  
The employer whose employees are exposed to a hazard
- CORRECTING**  
The employer responsible for correcting a hazardous condition
- CONTROLLING**  
The employer with general authority over the worksite

An employer can fall into **MORE THAN ONE** category.
