What workers say...

Approximately **one-third** of workers in high hazard industries do not believe safety is valued
50% say safety meetings are held less often than they should be
39% think management does the minimum required by law to keep employees safe
36% say safety takes a backseat to completing job tasks
30% say they are too afraid to report safety issues

An effective safety and health program can save
\$4-\$6 for every \$1 invested



Organizations with higher engagement scores had
70% fewer safety incidents
compared to those with low engagement.



5x less likely to have a safety incident.
7x less likely to have a lost-time safety incident.

Quick Tips for Employers

- Prioritize safety:** Have protocols in place. No shortcuts!

- Request input:** Give employees a voice in the safety program
- Use leading indicators:** Track systems, operations & behavior

- Dress for safety:** Always wear, clean & maintain your PPE
- Use the right tools:** Know your tools & machines thoroughly
- Love your body:** Take breaks & maintain correct posture
- Be diligent:** Report violations & unsafe conditions
