Here are six shocking facts about workplace violence in North America.

Odds of winning the lottery: 1 in 135,145,920 (multi-state, mega-millions jackpot)

Odds of being murdered in the United States: 1 in 133 (Bureau of Justice Statistics)

1. Sexual harassment affects 1 in 4 women in the workplace.
2. Nearly 2 million American workers are victims of violent crimes every year.
3. In the United States, police officers, corrections officers and taxi drivers are the 3 professions most at risk for experiencing violence during the course of their workday.
4. Homicide is the 4th leading cause of fatal occupational injury in the US.
5. In Canada, about 20 percent of all incidents of physical assault, sexual assault and robbery occur at the victims' workplaces.
6. About 21 percent of all workers have been bullied on the job.
