

# Vehicles: Pick Six

Lifetime odds of dying in a motor vehicle accident: 1 in 84

1: One in 10 Canadian drivers admit to driving after drinking too much alcohol on at least one occasion within the past 12 months.

2: Male drivers involved in fatal motor vehicle crashes are nearly twice as likely as female drivers to have been impaired by alcohol at the time.

15: In Canada an estimated 1,500 people die each year as a result of incidents involving impaired drivers.

32: An alcohol-related crash death occurs every 32 minutes somewhere in the United States.

39: Thirty-nine percent of all traffic-related deaths in the US in 2005 were alcohol related.

48: Forty-eight children ages 14 and younger were killed by impaired drivers while walking or riding bicycles in the United States in 2005.
