Do your research

- Look into the location you're going to be stationed in
- Research local wildlife and their characteristics and behaviours, such as denning and mating
- Call local fish and wildlife to learn about seasonal behaviour and timing, and try to avoid the most dangerous times

Avoid regular animal habitats at peak times

- Snakes sun themselves on rock ledges
- Scorpions are nocturnal
- Canids, cougars, and bears all have dens where they raise their young
- Bears fish in fresh water sources
- Large ungulates are often found in grassy meadows



By being aware of regular animal habitats and their peak times, you can avoid them, giving animals the space they need to feel safe.
