


Top 3 Tips for Yard Work Safety

1 Ready the Tools


Know your equipment

Before operating a new lawn mower read the owner's manual and all of the safety information. Ditto for your weed trimmer. Check with the manufacturer of your tools to make sure there haven't been any safety recalls.



Practice Ladder Safety

You've heard it again and again, but always check to make sure your ladder is firmly set on a level surface. Never set ladders on boxes or other objects to make the ladder reach higher areas. Lock or barricade any doors that may open toward ladders. Also, never stand on the top rung or step of a ladder - your balance could be jeopardized.



Check your extension cords

Before use, check your extension cords for cracks and seal them with electrical tape. If you find any frayed wires, replace the cord. And remember, never run extension cords through puddles.
